Summary of Duties:

Provides client care in the Psychology office setting. Completes psychoeducational and psychological evaluations. Conducts individual and family therapy.

Essential Functions:

Works both autonomously and collaboratively:

- Conducts psychoeducational evaluations for ADHD, learning disabilities, autism, emotional concerns, for school aged children and adolescents.
- Provides individual therapy within 50-minute sessions to children, adolescents, and teens from ages 3 to 25.
- Provides family therapy when working with pediatric populations.
- Accurately completes and maintains medical records and documents.
- Communicates with clinical and clerical teams, referring providers, patients and families to ensure continuity of care.
- Communication skills (both written and verbal) suitable to express the physical, mental and emotional status of patients and families.
- Maintains skills/knowledge base through reading, training and other structured in-services.
- Maintains strictest confidentiality; adheres to all HIPAA guidelines/regulations.
- Shows empathy, warmth, and acceptance. Exemplifies trustworthiness.
- Ability to adjust goals that work for the client/family. Flexibility and ability to adjust plans as needed.
- Ability to work in a cooperative environment being part of a team.

Education and Experience:

- Ph.D. or Psy.D in Clinical, Counseling, or School and then Licensed in SC or License Eligible.
- APA accredited.
- Experience with evidenced based practices and therapy models targeting anxiety and trauma, ADHD, depression, and/or behavioral challenges with adults and/or children and families preferred.
- Complex casework experience preferred.
- Two years' experience preferred.
